## SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR CHICAGO & VICNITY LABORERS' DISTRICT COUNCIL HEALTH & WELFARE PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report for Chicago & Vicinity Laborers' District Council Health & Welfare Plan, EIN 36-2151212 Plan 501, for the year ended May 31, 2022. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefit Security Administration as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

The board of trustees has committed themselves to pay certain claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

## **Insurance Information**

The Plan has contracts with The Union Labor Life Insurance Company to reimburse the Plan for certain claims paid for long-term disability, life insurance and accidental death and dismemberment claims. The premiums paid for the policy year ended May 31, 2022 was \$90,927.

## **Basic Financial Statement**

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan was \$574,266,533 as of May 31, 2022, compared to \$569,803,581 as of June 1, 2021. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$4,462,952. This increase included unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$220,191,117 including employer contributions of \$212,565,142 participant contributions of \$2,176,392, realized losses of \$(3,966,443) from the sale of assets, net investment losses of \$(17,457,936), and other income of \$26,873,962.

Plan expenses were \$215,728,165. These expenses included \$9,897,657 in administrative expenses and \$205,830,508 in benefits paid to or for participants and beneficiaries.
